No Children's Room/Sunday School - Today, July 6

This week, in honor of Pastor Magloire's first Sunday at Roselle UMC, the Children's Room will not be open. Child Care and Sunday School will not be offered. We value our children and will resume offering learning and care for them during worship on July 13.

Today, we invite children to remain in the sanctuary for worship and the introduction of our new Pastor. Children are also welcome to take communion with their parents.



Our July Mission Links projects will support the Midwest Mission Distribution Center (MMDC) located in Chatham, Illinois. Roselle UMC has supported the MMDC for decades in many ways. We have supported them through our donations of goods in support of the many mission projects they have going on. In August we will support them directly by sending a mission team to work on-site helping work on

whatever projects are most urgent at the time. We also support them as a Mission Links participant through our monthly mission giving. In July we ask you to donate to the MMDC for your monthly mission giving.

Since 2000, the Midwest Mission Distribution Center has shown God's love in practical ways through the distribution of education, health, micro-business and disaster relief supplies meeting basic human needs around the world and around the corner. MMDC distributes its kits, resources and supplies after receiving a request. Supplies are given free of charge regardless of gender, race or religion. MMDC connects with local aid organizations by providing items that are received that do not meet kit requirements. One of 10 cooperating depots in the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) Supply Network, MMDC distributes UMCOR supplies in response to disasters within the U.S. MMDC also partners with Christians in Mission, Food for the Poor, Franciscan Mission Warehouse, and U.S. Southern Command.

The second giving opportunity is to provide support to foreign students at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary. These are students who recently counted our new pastor as one of their own. Most of them will not be able to go home this summer out of fear that they might not be allowed back into the US. So here is what I would like to add to the news streams:

International students at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston will be unable to return home to families this summer out of fear that they may not be able to return to the United States in the fall to resume their studies. These are students who, until recently, counted our new pastor as one of their classmates. These students can certainly use our help with unexpected expenses this summer.

We have an opportunity to help these theological school students get through the summer. Gift cards are the best way we can do this. We are asking for donations of \$25 gift cards to either Jewel or Walmart. If you are able to purchase and donate these gift cards, please place them in the offering plate on any Sunday, or mail them to the church, or drop them off at the church office. We will get them to the students as quickly as possible.


