

There is no shame in being a recipient of Food Pantry Services – only the JOY of receiving and the JOY of sharing.



You are invited to join us at Midwest Mission's **Annual Rice and Soy Blessing Bag Pack on September 25 and 26, 2025!** We hope to pack **10,000 meals that will feed 60,000** people in crisis around the world. Would you consider joining us for a two-hour volunteer shift?

The Blessing Bag Pack, hosted at <u>Midwest Mission</u>, is a free, assembly-line style event to pack meals. This is a great opportunity to show God's love in a practical way, being the hands and feet of Jesus.

Blessing Bags are made of rice, soy, dehydrated vegetables, and a vitamin and seasoning pack. Many times, these meals are sent after disasters, during wars when food is scarce, or even during ongoing humanitarian crises such as the current situation in Haiti. Matthew 25:35-40 calls us to care for the hungry, and by joining in the Blessing Bag Pack, you have the opportunity to do that without leaving Central IL!
