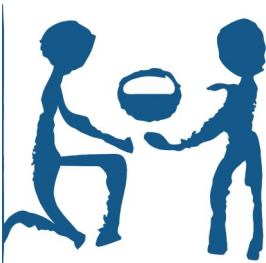

National Day of Prayer Observance

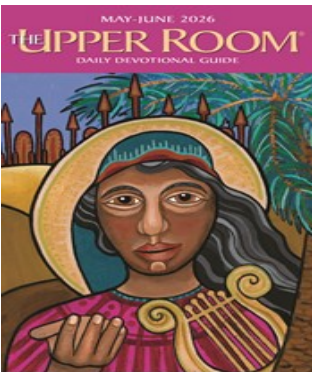
