Praying for the elderly members and for those who has been sick with Covid, flu, and cold.

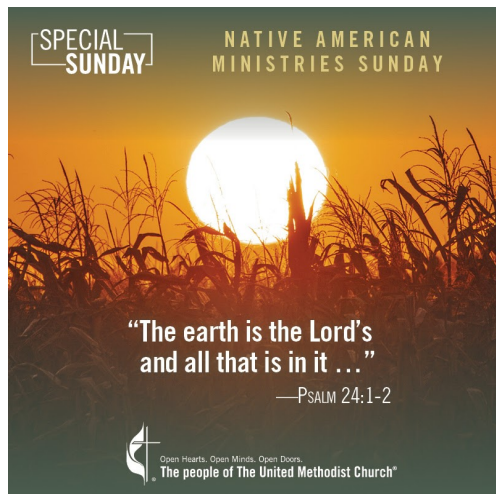
Pray for the asylum seekers, all Ukrainians, and the victims of natural disasters.

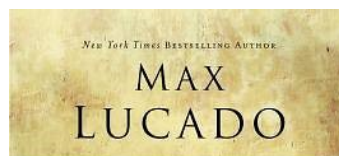
